DISCIPLINE POLICY PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS

Objective: The objective of this Discipline Policy is to help ensure a safe environment for the staff and participants involved in the Recreation Programs. The supervisor of the program is responsible for monitoring acceptable behavior among participants. Any form of harassment or bullying will not be accepted. Some examples of unacceptable behavior include name calling, explicit language, the use of physical force, and inappropriate use of equipment.

1st Offense: A discipline report will be filed by the supervisor of the program. In addition, the participant who is being disciplined will fill out a form describing how their actions affected their safety or the safety of another participant. The parent/guardian will be notified of the infraction by the Camp Director. The Parent/Guardian will also be notified that next offense will result in suspension from the program.

2nd Offense: Discipline Reports, telephone call to Parent/Guardian, suspension from the program for a day or for the remainder of the program.

***Each offense will be looked at case by case depending on the severity of the infraction.**

NOTE. If severity of discipline problem warrants, participant may be removed from program at any time.

A copy of all reports shall be filed with the Recreation Director.

Appeal process is via the Recreation Director.

When registering and clicking the box, it is understood that the parents agrees and will talk to their child about what type of behavior is required to participate in a Warren Township program. It also indicates that the parents will explain and encourage their child to report any unsafe behavior to their adult supervisor.
