K'NEX Amusement

Ages 7-13

Have you ever wondered how they make those incredible rides you see at the amusement park? Now you can discover them for yourself as you work with a class of other enthusiasts to design and build a working model amusement park. This course is sure to bring out the engineer in you! We build a wide range of model amusement park models using the K'NEX construction system. Projects include: a motorized swing, Double Ferris Wheel, Roller Coasters, Big Ball Factory, and Giant Ferris Wheel. Musical Carousel, Boom Ride, and many more! All students take home a K'NEX model as part of the program! Students have fun learning about simple and complex machinery, and physical science concepts including acceleration, Newton's Laws of Motion, speed, velocity, and more. Lego Star Wars & Motorized Machines

Ages 7-13

Lego enthusiasts, have fun building your favorite adventure from a Star Wars galaxy that is far, far away. Star Wars projects will vary depending on availability from the Lego Headquarters, but will probably include most of these NEW models which will vary by age level: Trifighter Droid, AT-DP, Tie Advanced Prototype, AAT, Hailfire Droid, Wookie Gunship, Battle-Droid Troopers, Droid Gunship, B-Wing, MTT, Star Destroyer, and more. We will also continue to stock the best of the some of the older models. In addition, students will build a wide assortment of motorized Lego machines with the Lego education motorized mechanisms curriculum that is designed to teach students just how those complex machines work. Topics include simple machines, mechanical advantage, gear ratios, and a host of others. With the new machine sets students can even create their own projects that illustrate science concepts. This is a stimulating enrichment program and not geared as a teacher-driven education class. All students will take home a Lego Star Wars project. Lunch Time:

Please pack your child a lunch, snack and drink. Water fountains are provided. Bring a reusable water bottle.

Drop off & pick up:

Drop off is at 8:45am. Please do not drop off more than 10 minutes early. The entrance will be off of Mt. Horeb Rd., drive to the side of the building and enter where you see the awning. This is the AP room. Do not park in front of the awning to drop off.

PICKUP time is 2:45pm. Please do not be late as the school closes the doors at 2:50pm. A late charge of \$5 for every 15 minutes will be charged to you if you are late.

Medical needs

Camp **will not** be able to administer drugs to your child, nor will we hold any medicine. Please administer medicine to your child either before and/or after the camp. If your child must carry **epi-pens** or inhalers, please notify our camp Instructor. If your child should get hurt, you will receive a medical report copy. Epinephrine/Epi-pens Authorization (if needed) and Parent Release forms need to be signed and mailed to the Recreation Department by Aug..3. Emergency number:

When you arrive at camp the first day you will be given the cell number of the supervisor. You can also call the Recreation office at 908-753-8000 ext 270. There is no need to call if your child will be missing a day.

Conduct

The idea of camp is to have fun and be safe. Any behavior problems will be dealt with at the camp first, and parents will be contacted if the problem continues. The parent must come in with the child to meet with the Director. If the problem persists, the child will be asked to leave the camp. According to N.J.A.C. 8:57-4, we must have the parent's signature that your child has received his/her immunizations against diphtheria, tetanus, polio, measles, pertussis, mumps & rubella or a letter stating you do not get the shots because of your beliefs.
