- 1) **Dead River:** A major clean up to the Dead River property for the past year which included removal of flood debris, cutting back and removing overgrown brush.
- 2) **Williams Property:** Removal of appliances dumped on the property, glass, metal and cans, etc.
- 3) **Stransky Property:** Clean up and removal of an old collapsed building on this property.

In addition to the cleanup of Township-owned properties, the Blue Ridge Club also:

- Assists with "Warren Annual Egg Hunt and Wagon Parade" to be held April 9, 2016, by providing prizes and helping with set up and registration.
- Sponsors and donates half the cost of Warren Fishing Derby held each May by supplying all food, cooking, prizes, presents fishing class for children and sets up booth of lines, sinkers, hooks, etc.
- Blue Ridge members provided fishing classes during the Recreation's summer camp program.

In November 2015 the WBRS members provided 50 turkeys and meals to Mount Bethel Village.

- **In January 2016, WBRS set up/provided all logistics for the Warren Recreation Yuletide Bonfire. Worked with Recreation Director to arrange tables, donations, set up tarps and tents, provided generators, heaters and prizes.**
- **In February 2016, WBRS concluded the 2015/2016 deer reduction program culling 86 deer and 13 fetuses in 48 days saving the Township the cost of hiring a deer management group. They donated over 450 lbs of venison to food kitchens.**
- **WBRS participates in the Somerset County Search and Rescue Unit.**

The Township Committee and the Recreation Commission are grateful and appreciative of the energy, enthusiasm and support by the Warren Blue Ridge Sportsmen members.
