MARRIAGE/ REMARRAIGE LICENSE

Application must be taken in the town in which Partner A or Partner B resides. For out of state applicants, application must be made in the town where the ceremony is to occur.

An appointment must be made by calling the Registrar in the Health Department at 908-753-8000, Ext. 239.

Required Documentation

- Proof of identity by presenting your driver's license, passport or state/federal I.D.
- Proof of residency (if not on Driver's License)
- Social Security number*
- A witness, 18 years of age or older
- The \$28 application fee (**Please bring exact cash or a personal check.**)

* Your social security number is required by law for US citizens and will be kept confidential.

Any documents in a foreign language must be accompanied by a certified English translation.

Requested additional documents (these documents are helpful but not required)

- A copy of your birth certificate to establish your parents' names and related birth information.
- If you are divorced, have had a previous civil union dissolved, domestic partnership terminated or have had a civil union annulled, please bring the decree(s) or the civil annulment documents.
- If your former spouse/civil union or domestic partner is deceased, please bring the death certificate.
- Officiant's name, address, phone number.

One witness is required for the marriage license application. Witness must be 18 years of age or older, know both the prospective bride and groom, and must speak English. Witness may be asked for proof of age.

There is a 72 hour waiting period before the license is issued. There is no waiting period for a remarriage, but must bring certified copy of existing marriage

The marriage license application is valid for six months from the date accepted, unless the Registrar has given prior approval to extend the validity of the application to a maximum of one year.

IF EITHER OR BOTH PARTNERS ARE MINORS

- If Partner A and/or Partner B are under the age of 18, both parents must come in along with two (2) other witnesses for the application.
- If Partner A and/or Partner B are under the age of 16, the above applies and you must get approval from a **Judge at the Somerset County Court House in Somerville NJ.**
