

**TOWNSHIP OF WARREN
RESOLUTION NO. 2018-281
AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR A SUSTAINABLE JERSEY GRANT
FOR ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATION IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$10,000**

WHEREAS, a sustainable community seeks to optimize quality of life for its residents by ensuring that its environmental, economic and social objectives are balanced and mutually supportive; and be a promote clean air through the use of electric vehicles.

WHEREAS, strives to save tax dollars, assure clean land, air and water, improve working and living environments; and reduce carbon emissions.

WHEREAS, Warren is participating in the Sustainable Jersey Program; and

WHEREAS, one of the purposes of the Sustainable Jersey Program is to provide resources to municipalities to make progress on sustainability issues, and they have created a grant program called the Sustainable Jersey Small Grants Program; and

WHEREAS, the Warren Township Green Team has prepared and recommended that the Township Committee authorize the filing of an application in the amount of \$10,000 to fund the cost of installation of a Electric Vehicle Charging Station at the Warren Township Municipal Complex.

1. The Township Committee hereby authorizes the submission of the Sustainable NJ Grant application for Electric Vehicle Charging Stations for funding in the amount of \$10,000 for the installation of an Electric Vehicle Charging Station.
2. The Township Committee hereby authorizes the filing of the grant application to Sustainable New Jersey.
