

**TOWNSHIP OF WARREN
RESOLUTION NO. 2018-87**

**AUTHORIZING DESIGNATING GAURISUTA REALTY, LLC
AS THE REDEVELOPER OF BLOCK 78, LOT 12
(THE FORMER KING GEORGE INN SITE)**

WHEREAS, the Township of Warren is a political subdivision of the State of New Jersey, located in the County of Somerset; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Warren (the "Township Committee"), by Resolution No. 2016-278, duly adopted on December 8, 2016, authorized the Planning Board to undertake a preliminary investigation to determine whether the area identified as Block 78, Lot 12 as shown on the Tax Map of the Township of Warren, Somerset County, New Jersey (the "Study Area"), should be declared "an area in need of redevelopment" according to the criteria set forth in Section 5 of the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1, *et seq.* (hereinafter "Redevelopment Law"); and

WHEREAS, John T. Chadwick, IV, P.P., Township Planner, submitted a report to the Planning Board entitled "Preliminary Redevelopment Area Study King George Inn Block 78, Lot 12) dated December 2016 (the "Redevelopment Area Study"), detailing the statutory criteria for determining whether the Study Area constituted an "area in need of redevelopment," and which Redevelopment Study provided extensive information supporting a recommendation to the Planning Board that the aforesaid Study Area met the statutory criteria; and

WHEREAS, after a public hearing held on February 13, 2017 and in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:12A-6, the Planning Board, on March 13, 2017, adopted a Resolution determining that the Study Area should be designated as an "area of redevelopment" and recommending that the Study Area be designated as an "area in need of redevelopment" pursuant to the Redevelopment Law; and

WHEREAS, after a review of the Study Area and the recommendation of the Planning Board, the Township Committee adopted Resolution No. 2017-103 on March 16, 2017, designating the Study Area as an "area in need of redevelopment" pursuant to the Redevelopment Law (the "Redevelopment Area"); and

WHEREAS, the Township Planner prepared and submitted a redevelopment plan entitled "King George Inn Area (B78 L12) Redevelopment Plan" (the "Redevelopment Plan"), outlining the planning, development and redevelopment of the Redevelopment Area in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-7; and

WHEREAS, on October 5, 2017, the Township Committee adopted Ordinance No. 17-19 adopting the Redevelopment Plan for the Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS, the Redeveloper proposes to redevelop Block 78 Lot 12 located in the Redevelopment Area (hereinafter referred to as the "Project Site"), by developing a residential project consisting of the construction of not more than 13 condominium "for sale" units in one building; and

WHEREAS, the Redeveloper (or an urban renewal entity controlled by the Redeveloper) owns the Project Site, and the Township Committee desires to conditionally designate **GAURISUTA REALTY, LLC** as the redeveloper of the Project Site.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Committee of the Township of Warren, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey does hereby conditionally designate **GAURISUTA REALTY, LLC** (or an urban renewal entity controlled by the Redeveloper), subject to the Redeveloper's compliance with the following conditions:

1. The Redeveloper enters into a Redevelopment Agreement with the Township of Warren, duly adopted by formal Resolution of the Township Committee in form and substance satisfactory to the Township Attorney; and
2. The Redeveloper secures preliminary and final site plan approval for the Project Site from the Planning Board and all agencies, boards, or bodies having jurisdiction over the Project Site or over the Redeveloper.
