

FIRE PIT REQUIREMENTS

- Must be in a UL listed commercially built/manufactured (Stone, Cement or Metal) for the purpose of being a “burning container” with an ember-suppressing lid.
- Any “built” on-site pit may need a Construction Department permit.
- Use only clean dry wood! NO brush, leaves, trash, treated or wet wood may be burned.
- Do not use any flammable liquids to ignite the fire.
- Fire pit must be 15 feet away from any combustibles, do NOT place fire pit on combustible decks or near any structures.
- Must have a garden hose stretched to the fire pit or a fire extinguisher near the fire pit.
- The fire pit must be attended while in use and MUST be extinguished when no longer in use or before being left unattended.
- If we receive complaints of smoke or embers and have to respond, we will make you extinguish the fire.
