**AWARD OF CONTRACT  
ENFORSYS POLICE SYSTEMS, INC.  
NIBRS-COMPLIANT POLISYS CAD/RMS/MOBILE SOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Warren ("Township") has a need for a NIBRS-COMPLIANT POLISYS CAD/RMS/MOBILE SOLUTION system (the "Police Records Management System") to allow the Township Police Department to update the Police Record Management System in order to meet the requirements of the National/ Crime Statistic Exchange; and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5dd et seq., permits the award of a contract for the provision or performance of goods or services for the support or maintenance of proprietary computer hardware and software, except that this provision shall not be utilized to acquire or upgrade non-proprietary hardware or to acquire or update non-proprietary software, without public advertisement; and

**WHEREAS**, Enforsys Police Systems, Inc. ("Enforsys"), by email dated September 4, 2018 has advised the Township Administrator that the software for the upgrade is proprietary in that it is of a specialized nature since the Enforsys 4.0 CAD RMS system used by the Warren Police Department was designed to work exclusively with the Enforsys NIBRS architecture and the Enforsys NIBRS architecture was developed for use exclusively with the Enforsys 4.0 system; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township received a quote (the "Quote") dated September 23, 2017 from Enforsys for the provision of proprietary goods and services for the System in the amount of \$43,500.00; and

**WHEREAS**, The Township Administrator & QPA recommend that a contract (the "Contract") be awarded to Enforsys pursuant to the Quote as the Warren Police Department is currently utilizing Enforsys software and an upgrade is required to meet United States Department of Justice reporting requirements, and furthermore, the implementation of the hardware and software from a single vendor will ensure proper performance; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer certifies that funds to pay for this Contract at a maximum dollar amount of \$43,500 dollars are available in Account No. X-02-40-765-6901, subject to the adoption of Resolution No. 2018-213, which authorized the insertion of grant funds to the 2018 budget for the purchase of the Police Records Management System. A Certification of Available Funds shall be provided by the Chief Financial Officer and is attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee certifies that the Police Records Management System is necessary for the conduct of its affairs in accurate records management by the Warren Police Department.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Warren, County of Somerset and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The Township Committee hereby awards a Contract in the amount of \$43,500.00 to Enforsys Police Systems, Inc. for the provision of proprietary goods and services for the Police Records Management System pursuant to quote dated September 23, 2017.
2. This Contract is awarded without competitive bidding under the Local Public Contracts Law, in accordance with N.J.S.A 40A:11-5dd, as described above.
3. The Business Disclosure Entity Certification shall be placed on file with this Resolution.
