

**TOWNSHIP OF WARREN  
ORDINANCE NO. 21-07**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE AMOUNT OF \$29,000 AS AN APPROPRIATION  
FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PURCHASE OF SIX  
TOUGHBOOK COMPUTERS FOR USE BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Warren, in the County of Somerset and State of New Jersey as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the Police Chief has recommended the purchase of six (6) Toughbook computers with MDT Docking Stations for installation in vehicles to replace existing equipment for use by the Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Administrator has recommended that the Police Chief's request for computers be phased over two years with 6 being purchased in 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee desires to proceed with this project; and

**WHEREAS**, funds are available in the Capital Improvement Fund, Account No. 1-04-225-55-3200.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Warren, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey as follows:

- Section 1) The capital improvement herein described below is hereby authorized as a capital improvement to be made by the Township of Warren, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, and for the said improvement there is hereby authorized the sum of \$29,000.
- Section 2) The purpose of this appropriation is for the purchase of six or more Toughbook computers for installation in vehicles for use by the Police Department as funding permits.
- Section 3) There is hereby authorized an appropriation from the Capital Improvement Fund Account No. 0-04-225-55-3200 for \$29,000. Prior to the effective date of this Ordinance, the Chief Financial Officer shall certify that sufficient funds are available in the Capital Improvement Fund to make the said appropriation. The certification is incorporated within the Ordinance.
- Section 4) The Capital Budget of the Municipality is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies therewith.
- Section 5) Any further action regarding this project may be effectuated by resolution of the Township Committee.
- Section 6) If any section or provision hereof shall be adjudged invalid, such determination shall not affect any other provisions hereof, which shall remain in full force and effect.
- Section 7) This Ordinance shall be effective upon final adoption and publication thereof in accordance with law.
