

Explanation: This Ordinance amends the fee for reinstatement of a construction permit that has become invalid.

AN ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTING AND AMENDING SECTION 8-2 ENTITLED
“FEES” OF CHAPTER VIII ENTITLED “BUILDING AND HOUSING” OF *THE*
***REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WARREN* BY**
AMENDING SUBSECTION 8-2.1 ENTITLED “CONSTRUCTION PERMIT FEE.”

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Warren, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection 8-2.1 entitled “Construction Permit Fee” of Section 8-2 entitled “Fees” of Chapter VIII entitled “Building and Housing” of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Warren is hereby amended to revise clause i. to read as follows:

1. The fee for reinstatement of a construction permit that has become invalid in accordance with the UCC shall be [~~\$340.00~~]\$85.00 per subcode, per outstanding permit[.], but shall not exceed \$340.00.

SECTION 2. If any article, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance and they shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. In the event of any inconsistencies between the provisions of this Ordinance and any prior ordinance of the Township of Warren, the provisions hereof shall be determined to govern. All other parts, portions and provisions of *The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Warren* are hereby ratified and confirmed, except where inconsistent with the terms hereof.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication according to law.
