

TOWNSHIP OF WARREN
ORDINANCE NO. 22-20

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION 2-3.1 OF SECTION 2-3 ENTITLED “POLICE DEPARTMENT OF CHAPTER 2 ENTITLED “ADMINISTRATION” BY INCLUDING A CAPTAIN AMONG THE RANKS OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND BY INCREASING THE NUMBER OF SERGEANTS FROM SIX TO SEVEN

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Warren, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that clause a. of subsection 2-3.1 entitled “Establishment and Organization” of Section 2-3 entitled “Police Department” of Chapter 2 entitled “Administration” of the General Ordinances of the Township of Warren, as heretofore supplemented and amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

- a. The Township of Warren Police Department, as has been heretofore legally established under applicable laws of the State of New Jersey, is continued. The police department shall consist of no more than a chief of police, one captain, three lieutenants, [six] seven sergeants, twenty-five patrol officers and detectives, special law enforcement officers and such other superior officers and patrol persons as will be determined by the Township Committee from time to time as being proper and feasible for the department, upon recommendation of the chief of police and the Township Administrator. These members of the Warren Township Police Department shall be duly sworn.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication according to law.
