A RESOLUTION CONSENTING TO THE PROPOSED WATER
QUALITY MANAGEMENT (WQM) PLAN AMENDMENT
ENTITLED: DESIGNATION OF THE CAWLEY CROSSING SEWER SERVICE AREA

WHEREAS, the Township of Warren desires to provide for the orderly development of wastewater facilities within the Township of Warren; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) requires that proposed wastewater treatment and conveyance facilities and wastewater treatment service areas, as well as related subjects, be in conformance with an approved WQM plan; and

WHEREAS, the NJDEP has established the WQM plan amendment procedure as the method of incorporating unplanned facilities into a WQM plan; and

WHEREAS, a proposed WQM plan amendment to the Northeast Water Quality Management Plan as prepared by Natural Systems Utilities is being filed with NJDEP for the Designation of the Cawley Crossing Sewer Service Area on Block 83, Lot 4 in Warren Township; and

WHEREAS, the wastewater producing project associated with the proposed WQM plan amendment is consistent with the land use identified in the municipal master plan and zoning ordinances of the Township of Warren.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED on this 15th day of September, 2022, by the Township Committee of the Township of Warren, Somerset County, New Jersey, that:

1. The Township of Warren hereby consents to the amendment entitled Designation of the Cawley Crossing Sewer Service Area, prepared by Natural Systems Utilities, for the purpose of its incorporation into the applicable WQM plan.
2. This consent shall be submitted to the NJDEP in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:15-3.4.
