

TOWNSHIP OF WARREN
RESOLUTION NO. 2022-285
AUTHORIZES THE EXECUTION OF THE CONTRACT FOR THE
WATCHUNG HILLS REGIONAL MUNICIPAL ALLIANCE GRANT
July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023

WHEREAS, the Governor’s Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse established the Municipal Alliance for the Prevention of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse in 1989 to educate and engage residents, local government and law enforcement officials, schools, nonprofit organizations, the faith community, parents, youth and other allies in efforts to prevent alcoholism and drug abuse in communities throughout New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, The Township Committee of the Township of Warren, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey recognizes that the abuse of alcohol and drugs is a serious problem in our society amongst persons of all ages and, therefore, has an established a Municipal Alliance Committee; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Committee further recognizes that it is incumbent upon not only public officials but upon the entire community to take action to prevent such abuses in our community; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Committee applied for funding to the Governor’s Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse through the County of Somerset; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Warren, County of Somerset, and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The Township Committee does hereby authorize a strategic plan for the Watchung Hills Regional Municipal Alliance (Warren, Watchung, Green Brook, Long Hill) grant for fiscal year 2022-2023 in the amount of:

Cash Match	\$ 2,016.29
In-Kind	\$ 6,048.84

2. The Township Committee acknowledges the terms and conditions for administering the Municipal Alliance grant program, including the administrative compliance and audit requirements and does hereby authorize the appropriate municipal official(s) to sign the contract agreement
3. Warren Township accepts subsequent award of this grant.
4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption according to law.
