

**ARE YOU INTERESTED IN A
PARK-N-RIDE SERVICE
IN WARREN TOWNSHIP?**

The Warren Township Committee, represented by Township Committeeman George Lazo, is working in conjunction with the Somerset County Board of Chosen Freeholders, Somerset County Planning Division, and Ridewise Executive Director, Donna Allison. The Township Committee is seeking to establish a Park and Ride location for Bus Service to Newark, Jersey City and New York City in order to increase the commuting options for Warren residents.

The goal is to improve the quality of life and commuting time of our residents. The proposed Park and Ride location has not been determined but will likely be within 1 mile from Exit 36 at I-78.

The regional private commuter bus carriers will consider offering this amenity to Warren residents if the Township can demonstrate sufficient interest in utilizing this service.
