Warren Township Moves Forward on Affordable Housing Plans

The Warren Township Committee continues to aggressively negotiate with the Fair Share Housing Center to establish Warren's Affordable Housing obligation that meets with Court approval but does not significantly impact the character of our town.

The Township Committee's efforts reached a milestone on Friday, June 8, 2018, with Judge Miller granting Warren Township's motion for approval of the proposed 100% affordable family rental housing development on Lindbergh Avenue that is to be built by PIRHL Acquisitions, LLC.

"Warren Township is to be praised for moving forward proactively," wrote counsel for the Fair Share Housing Center, Adam Gordon, in a letter of support to Judge Miller. "While other significant issues remain..., FSHC supports the Township's work to move forward," he said.

The Township Committee continues to seek its ultimate Affordable Housing number through on-going and active discussions with Fair Share Housing Center's counsel.

"This is a big step forward in our effort to ensure that all development is done in the most thoughtful and strategic way. I am proud of our Township officials as we have continuously fulfilled our obligations in a way that allows for these new residents to seamlessly become a part of our community," said Mayor Victor Sordillo.

Warren Township officials seek an Affordable Housing obligation that is responsible, fits with the town's character, and has minimal impact on our schools, infrastructure, and town services.
