Somerset County Freeholder Deputy Director Patricia Walsh has announced that the next "Buy One, Bring One" collection of food for Somerset County families and individuals in need will be held **Friday, Jan. 18**. "The Food Bank Network relies on these donations all year round," she said, adding that the program has collected more than 44 tons of donations since its inception in 2010. "The bins are available all month, so if you miss the third Friday, you are welcome to drop off your items at any time during regular business hours," she said.
