

WARREN TOWNSHIP RECREATION PAVILION AND FIELD USAGE FEES

Ordinance # 2-20-4b

Fees for Use of Recreational Facilities. All applicants seeking the use of the Township of Warren's Pavilion and Athletic Fields (grass and synthetic turf) must complete a Department of Recreation facility use application and pay the fee prescribed by the following table:

Non-Residents & Out-of-Town for Profit entities	\$50 (1hr)
(Synthetic Turf Fields)	
Nonprofit entities at least 90% Regional & In-Town for Profit entities* (**)	\$100(3hrs)
Non-Residents & Out-of-Town for Profit entities	\$100 (1 hr)
Refund Processing Fee	\$20 per transaction

*A township nonprofit entity is one in which at least 90% of the organization is comprised of Regional participants. Regional participants. For the purpose of this subsection, "Regional" shall mean sending districts to Watchung Hills Regional High School, which includes Long Hill, Watchung Borough and Green Brook ("Regional Sending District Towns"). Regional Sending District Towns shall cooperate with reciprocal use of fields. The 90% Regional requirement for a nonprofit shall not apply to special need sports. No Warren resident will be turned away from playing a recreational sport if they are registered by the deadline or before teams have been chosen, which dates shall be determined by the sports clubs and well-advertised to town residents. Warren Township is inclusive and welcomes all children.

(**)The township committee has the right to adjust usage fees if the nonprofit can prove the percentage of Regional Sending District Towns fields and users are comparable to the percentage of Warren Township fields and users.

NOTE: ANY NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION OBTAINING USE OF A TOWNSHIP RECREATIONAL FACILITY IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED FROM SUBLETTING ITS USE TO ANOTHER ENTITY.
