SPECIAL TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
May 1, 2020, 9:30 AM

Clerk Reese called the meeting to order at 9:34 AM and read the following statement:
The meeting will be an electronic meeting via ZOOM. The meeting will be open to the public via audio only. The Township will post the meeting information for public comment on the Township website by 8:00 AM, Friday May 1st, 2020.

The meeting will be opened to the public for that portion of the meeting devoted to:

1. Privilege of the floor

You will need to give your name and address upon entering the meeting.

In compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act of New Jersey, adequate notice of this meeting was provided by sending written notices of this Notice to the Star Ledger, Courier News and Echoes Sentinel, posting on the Township website and filing with the Township Clerk.

No mention of political affiliation or political advertising shall take place at this meeting or it will be deleted from any rebroadcast of the meeting.

Public comments at the public hearings for ordinances and resolutions as well as agenda items, are limited to 3 minutes per person, unless extended discussion is permitted by the Mayor.

Clerk Reese hosted the meeting with Administrator Krane and Attorney Lehrer also present via their personal computers.

NEW BUSINESS:

Clerk Reese read the following Resolution by title:

EXTEND SECOND QUARTER TAXES DUE DATE TO MAY 29, 2020

Committeeman DiNardo made a Motion to Approve, seconded by Committeeman Sordillo.

Administrator Krane noted that the chosen May 29th deadline for extension of the property tax deadline was due to the fact that May 29th is a Friday.

Committeewoman Maziarz, noted that the reason that this Resolution was not done sooner, was because the Governor did not issue the Order allowing municipalities to extend the deadline until late afternoon, April 28th, 2020.

Which in following the Open Public Meeting Act Guidelines, a 48 hour meeting notice was required before the Township Committee could meet to approve the resolution.
