Now that the weather is getting warmer, the Warren Township Committee is reminding residents that Township Parks and Trails are open for passive recreation. Tennis Courts are open in accordance with the posted restrictions. Playgrounds, basketball courts, and fields for organized sports remain closed in accordance with Governor Murphy’s Executive Order #133.

Mayor Marion stated, “The Township Committee and I are making all efforts to continue reviewing areas of recreational use to make them available to residents while abiding by the Governor’s order. We want to encourage everyone to get out and enjoy the parks and trails that are open to the extent possible, while maintaining social distancing. “
