



Attention Warren Township Residents

The Governor's Executive Order 144 defined the July 7, 2020 Primary Election as a primarily Vote-By-Mail election. Instead of mailing sample ballots to residents, Somerset County will be sending postage paid Vote-by-Mail ballots to all active registered Democrat and Republican voters. These ballots will be mailed out from the County offices on or about **06/12/2020**. Unaffiliated or inactive Democrat or Republican voters can complete a Vote-by-Mail application that must be returned by **06/30/2020**.

For the safety of our voters and poll workers, the Warren Township Clerk's Office is strongly urging all residents to please take advantage of Vote-by-Mail ballots to cast your vote. The postage paid mail in ballots can be returned via the United States Postal Service or dropped off at one of the five drop boxes that will be located throughout Somerset County. The locations of these drop boxes will be announced as soon as that information is available.

In lieu of voting by mail, a provisional (paper) ballot can be completed at the polling location on Primary Election Day. **Mail in ballots cannot be accepted at the polling location.** The County Clerk and the Board of Elections have determined that the only polling location in Warren Township for the July 7 Primary Election will be located at the **Warren Township Municipal Court**. The polls will be open 6:00 am until 8:00 pm. Social distancing, masks and sanitary guidelines will be followed. There will only be one voting machine available and that is reserved for *residents with disabilities requiring an ADA voting system*. **YOU MAY ONLY VOTE BY PROVISIONAL BALLOT AT THE MUNICIPAL COURT.**
