

**TOWNSHIP OF WARREN  
ORDINANCE NO. 14-12**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE AMOUNT OF \$35,000 AS AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE CAPITAL FUND BALANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE SHINGLE & FLAT RUBBER ROOFS AT THE POLICE/COURT BUILDING AT 44 MOUNTAIN BLVD**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Warren, in the County of Somerset and State of New Jersey as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the Warren Township Superintendent of Public Works has recommended that the shingle and flat rubber roofs at the Police/Court Building be replaced; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee has agreed to said recommendation; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary that steps be taken to provide for the establishment of the necessary financial authorization in accordance with New Jersey financial procedures to implement this project; and

**WHEREAS**, funds are available in the Capital Fund Balance Account No. 4-04-400-65-3800;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Warren, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1) The improvement herein described below is hereby authorized as a capital improvement to be made by the Township of Warren, County of Somerset, New Jersey and for the said improvement there is hereby authorized the sum of \$35,000.00.

Section 2) The purpose of this appropriation is for replacing the shingle and flat rubber roofs to the Police/Court Building at 42 Mountain Blvd which is in need of replacement, and said appropriation to include installation, all necessary architectural and/or engineering including all equipment, labor and other appurtenances.

Section 3) There is hereby authorized an appropriation from the Capital Fund Balance Account No. 4-04-400-65-3800 in the amount of \$35,000. The Township Chief Financial Officer shall, prior to the effective date of this ordinance, certify that sufficient funds are available in the Capital Fund Balance to make the said appropriation. The certification is incorporated within the ordinance.

Section 4) The Capital Budget of the Municipality is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies therewith.

Section 5) Any further action regarding this project may be effectuated by resolution of the Township Committee.

Section 6) If any section or provision hereof shall be adjudged invalid, such determination shall not affect any other provisions hereof, which shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 7) This Ordinance shall be effective upon final adoption and publication thereof in accordance with law.


