

EXPLANATION: This Ordinance provides funding for the purchase of Mobile-Vision Cameras for police patrol vehicles

**TOWNSHIP OF WARREN
ORDINANCE NO. 18-10**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE AMOUNT OF \$23,000 AS AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF MOBILE-VISION CAMERAS FOR POLICE PATROL VEHICLES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Warren, in the County of Somerset and State of New Jersey as follows:

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has requested the replacement of the existing flashback cameras installed in 8 of the police vehicles, which are currently 10-years old and due for replacement.

WHEREAS, the Township Administrator has recommended that this project be phased over a 2-year period.

WHEREAS, funds are available in the Capital Improvement Fund, Account No. 8-04-225-55-3200.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Warren, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1) The capital improvement herein described below is hereby authorized as a capital improvement to be made by the Township of Warren, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey and for the said improvement there is hereby authorized the sum of \$23,000.

Section 2) The purpose of this appropriation is for the purchase four Mobile-Vision Flashback 3HD MVR cameras and related equipment, including installation, for police patrol vehicles as directed by the Chief of Police.

Section 3) There is hereby authorized an appropriation from the Capital Improvement Fund Account No. 8-04-225-55-3200 for \$23,000. The Chief Financial Officer shall, prior to the effective date of this ordinance, certify that sufficient funds are available in the Capital Fund Balance to make the said appropriation. The certification is incorporated within the Ordinance.

Section 4) The Capital Budget of the Municipality is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies therewith.

Section 5) Any further action regarding this project may be effectuated by resolution of the Township Committee.

Section 6) If any section or provision hereof shall be adjudged invalid, such determination shall not affect any other provisions hereof, which shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 7) This Ordinance shall be effective upon final adoption and publication thereof in accordance with law.
