

EXPLANATION: This Ordinance provides funding for the purchase and installation of a new Gas Dispensing System, Software, and related equipment for the use of fueling vehicles.

**TOWNSHIP OF WARREN
ORDINANCE NO. 18-11**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE AMOUNT OF \$45,000 AS AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A NEW GAS DISPENSING SYSTEM, SOFTWARE, AND RELATED EQUIPMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Warren, in the County of Somerset and State of New Jersey as follows:

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Public Works is recommending the replacement of the existing Gas Dispensing System, Software, and related equipment that was originally placed into operation 1995. The existing software is not compatible with current operating software and the dispensing equipment is old, rusty, and damaged. The total cost of the project is \$55,000.

WHEREAS, the Township Administrator has recommended the funding of this equipment as follows: \$10,000 from Account No. X-04-55-825-6001 and \$45,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund for a total of \$55,000.

WHEREAS, the gas dispensing system is utilized for Public Works and other Township department vehicles, police vehicles, fire department, rescue squad, as well as fuel is resold to the Warren Gasoline Resale Program members, including but not limited to Watchung Regional High School, Warren Board of Education, Somerset County, Greenbrook Township, Greenbrook School District, and Middlebrook Regional Health Commission. It is imperative that proper tracking software be operational.

WHEREAS, funds are available in the Capital Improvement Fund, Account No. 8-04-225-55-3200.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Warren, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1) The Capital Improvement herein described below is hereby authorized as a capital improvement to be made by the Township of Warren, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey and for the said improvement there is hereby authorized the sum of \$45,000.

Section 2) The purpose of this appropriation is for the purchase of a Gas Dispensing System, Software, and related equipment, to be located at the Department Of Public Works.

Section 3) There is hereby authorized an appropriation from the Capital Improvement Fund Account No. 8-04-225-55-3200 for \$45,000. The Chief Financial Officer shall, prior to the effective date of this ordinance, certify that sufficient funds are available in the Capital Improvement Fund to make the said appropriation. The certification is incorporated within the Ordinance.

Section 4) The Capital Budget of the Municipality is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies therewith.

Section 5) Any further action regarding this project may be effectuated by resolution of the Township Committee.

Section 6) If any section or provision hereof shall be adjudged invalid, such determination shall not affect any other provisions hereof, which shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 7) This Ordinance shall be effective upon final adoption and publication thereof in accordance with law.


