

Explanation: This Ordinance amends Chapter II entitled “Administration” of *The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Warren* by revising Section 2-22 entitled “Historic Sites Committee” by reducing the number of members to twelve.

ORDINANCE 19-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WARREN IN THE COUNTY OF SOMERSET, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO AMEND THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WARREN BY REVISING SECTION 2-22 ENTITLED “HISTORIC SITES COMMITTEE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Warren, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Subsection 2-22.1 entitled “Establishment; Members: Terms” of Section 2-22 entitled “Historic Sites Committee” of Chapter II entitled “Administration” of *The Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Warren* is hereby amended to read as follows:

2-22.1 *Establishment; Members; Terms.* There is hereby established a historic sites committee to consist of [18] 15 members appointed by the township committee. The committee members first appointed shall serve for terms of one, two or three years in such a manner that the terms of one-third of the members will expire each year and their successors shall be appointed for terms of three years and until the appointment and qualification of their successors. [A minimum of] Up to three (3) members [shall] may be members in good standing of the Trustees of the Baptist Church and Congregation of Mt. Bethel, also known as Mt. Bethel Baptist Church. All committee members shall be residents of the township and shall serve without compensation. A vacancy on the committee occurring otherwise than by expiration of a term shall be filled for the unexpired term in the same manner as an original appointment.

SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or any other part of this Ordinance is adjudged to be unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of the Ordinance.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication according to law.
