

**EXPLANATION:** This Ordinance provides funding for the improvements, renovations or demolition of the former municipal building.

**TOWNSHIP OF WARREN  
ORDINANCE NO. 19-51**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE AMOUNT OF \$200,000 AS AN APPROPRIATION FROM CAPITAL FUND BALANCE TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENTS, RENOVATIONS OR DEMOLITION OF THE FORMER MUNICIPAL BUILDING.**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Warren, in the County of Somerset and State of New Jersey as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Warren has constructed a New Town Hall which opened for occupancy in February, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee is in the process of determining the future of the former Municipal Building located at the Municipal Complex, which may include improvement, renovations or demolition of the existing building; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Warren, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1) The capital improvement herein described below is hereby authorized as a capital improvement to be made by the Township of Warren, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey and for the said improvement there is hereby authorized the sum of \$200,000.

Section 2) The purpose of this appropriation is to provide funding for the improvement, renovation or demolition of the former municipal building, including but not limited to all engineering, architectural, and other related improvements as determined by action of the Township Committee.

Section 3) There is hereby authorized an appropriation from the Capital Fund Balance Account No. 9-04-400-65-3800 for \$200,000. The Chief Financial Officer shall, prior to the effective date of this ordinance, certifying that sufficient funds are available in the Capital Fund Balance to make the said appropriation. The certification is incorporated within the Ordinance.

Section 4) The Capital Budget of the Municipality is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies therewith.

Section 5) Any further action regarding this project may be effectuated by resolution of the Township Committee.

Section 6) If any section or provision hereof shall be adjudged invalid, such determination shall not affect any other provisions hereof, which shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 7) This Ordinance shall be effective upon final adoption and publication thereof in accordance with law.
