

EXPLANATION: This Ordinance provides funding for the purchase and installation of a new garage doors at the Public Works building.

**TOWNSHIP OF WARREN
ORDINANCE NO. 20-16**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE AMOUNT OF \$21,000 AS AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF NEW GARAGE DOORS AT THE PUBLIC WORKS BUILDING.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Warren, in the County of Somerset and State of New Jersey as follows:

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Public works has requested the replacement of the garage doors at the Public Works building; and

WHEREAS, the Township Administrator has recommended the purchase; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee desires to proceed with this project; and

WHEREAS, funds are available in the Capital Improvement Fund, Account No. 0-04-225-55-3200.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Warren, in the County of Somerset, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1) The capital improvement herein described below is hereby authorized as a capital improvement to be made by the Township of Warren, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey and for the said improvement there is hereby authorized the sum of \$21,000.

Section 2) The purpose of this appropriation is for the purchase and installation of new garage doors on the Public Works building, including all labor, materials, and related equipment. The specific doors are to be determined by the Superintendent of Public Works.

Section 3) There is hereby authorized an appropriation from the Capital Improvement Fund Account No. 0-04-225-55-3200 for \$21,000. Prior to the effective date of this Ordinance, the Chief Financial Officer shall certify that sufficient funds are available in the Capital Improvement Fund to make the said appropriation. The certification is incorporated within the Ordinance.

Section 4) The Capital Budget of the Municipality is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies therewith.

Section 5) Any further action regarding this project may be effectuated by resolution of the Township Committee.

Section 6) If any section or provision hereof shall be adjudged invalid, such determination shall not affect any other provisions hereof, which shall remain in full force and effective.

Section 7) This Ordinance shall be effective upon final adoption and publication thereof in accordance with law.
